Scholarship Information

The NCMA Scholarship is a monetary award up to \$500, awarded annually. All applicants must be an immediate relative of a member of the Northern West Virginia NCMA Chapter. NCMA considers an immediate relative to be a child, step-child, or grandchild. Scholarship recipients may not reapply for a total of two semesters after being awarded the scholarship.

Scholarship Committee

The NCMA Scholarship Committee will consist of approximately four individuals. The committee will strictly base their decision in a fair and just manner based on the following criteria.

- Scholastic achievement and motivation for higher education
- Qualities and traits of leadership, citizenship, and service to school and community
- Response to essay portion and application
- Letters of recommendation

Essay

The essay must be typed in 12 point font, double-spaced, and shall not exceed the two page limit.

January 28, 2011 – Application issued to the Chapter

February 24, 2011 – Application due

February 28, 2011 – Committee makes final recipient selection

March 1, 2011 – Scholarship awarded
